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## Module 1 Information

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## Other Training Materials Update

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All other training updates will take place in June 2011.

### Module 13 and 21

A new version of Module 13: Growing the Movement, Section Leaders (which will be called Developing the Section) and Module 21: Growing the Movement, Managers (which will be called Developing the Movement). This will include trainers' notes, workbooks and supporting material.

### Adults Personal File (APF) and TAG updates
