**Title:** Occasional Helper (England, Wales and Northern Ireland)

**Outline:** Occasional Helpers are adult volunteers who support and assist the Section Leaders, Assistant Section Leaders and Section Assistants in delivering the programme to young people in Scouting.

**Responsible to:** Group Scout Leader

**Main Contacts:** Young people, parents/carers, Section Leaders, other Section-based volunteers, Group Scout Leader or District Explorer Scout Commissioner, Young Leaders.

**Appointment requirements:** Complete a Personal Enquiry including a Disclosure Check
